TIGRIS™ PREMIER3

Classroom Function – Handing Guide



Tigris™ Premier3 is a range of master key cylinders ideal for use where high security and complex master keying are paramount.

Often in environments such as Education and Healthcare, there can be a requirement to restrict operation of the thumb turn to prevent door locking. By preventing operation of the thumb turn in either a clockwise or anti-clockwise direction, nuisance locking and barricade situations can be avoided. For ease and convenience, Tigris™ Premier3 cylinders can be provided Dual Handed (DH), this allows handing of the cylinder on site.

NB. In such situations it is always possible to use the thumb turn to *unlock* the door. Key operation is not affected.

Depending upon the handing required, a blocking PIN is inserted into chamber 3 or chamber 4 on the turn side of the cylinder. Chamber 3 is the third chamber from the end of the cylinder, chamber 4 is the fourth chamber from the end of the cylinder.

Remove the grub screw, carefully remove the spring and blocking pin. Insert the blocking PIN in the required chamber, ensure that the spring and grub screw is replaced.

NB. Do not overtighten the grub screw.

Chamber 3 – Clockwise Unlocking – turn can be rotated clockwise

Chamber 4 – Anti-Clockwise Unlocking – turn can be rotated anti-clockwise
